### Desired qualifications

- A doctoral degree in an appropriate basic or applied business or social science discipline, such as hospitality, tourism, marketing, management, economics, or finance and an outstanding average grade on your university degree (habilitation is not required).
- Professional and/or academic expertise in one or more of the following: Strategic Hotel Management, Hotel Finance and Controlling, Hotel Development, Rooms Division Management, F&B Management. Ideally, the candidate should have a proven record of tourism consultancy and project work in the areas of hospitality investment and analysis, hospitality real estate planning and development or operational controlling.
- A proven track record of teaching experience in one or more of the above fields and the ability to relate to students from diverse backgrounds.
- Fluent in the English language.
- Solid skills in research methods.

### Responsibilities

- Teaching and conducting examinations independently (the teaching load for this position is 10 units/week per semester (1 unit = 45 minutes of teaching; 2 – 3 courses per semester).
- Establishing relationships with the industry and developing a field of **applied research** related to hospitality management.
- Contributing to administrative and academic services.

### **Salary and Application Process**

The initial salary is EUR 55,000 before taxes, with additional remuneration for extra teaching and outstanding applied research. The position remains open until filled; the review of applications will commence in June 2016.
